The Beijing Underground's Line Ten will soon have 40 "reverse vending machines (有偿自动回收机)",which will pay people for their empty plastic bottles.

"We have placed two such machines at Beijing Capital International Airport and four at the city's underground stations. They have been well received so far," said Feng Juan, an engineer from the company which makes the machines. "People are encouraged and paid for turning waste into treasure. More than 30,000 empty bottles have been collected since December," she said.

If something else, such as waste paper, is thrown into the machine, the machine will spit(11) it out.

"Supported by the government, the reverse vending machines will be introduced to colleges and universities soon," Feng said.

The company is also considering covering more <u>recycling</u> materials, including used books and teaching materials.

"Long-term plans call for about 2,000 reverse vending machines to be place throughout the city in the next few years, including 80 at colleges and universities, shopping malls, communities and office buildings," Feng said.

Chang Tao, director of the company, said that if the new project works well in the city, the company will consider offering the waste-to-treasure service to other developed cities in the eastern part of China.

C

I came to study in the USA a year ago. Yet I did not know the real American society until I injured (伤害) in an accident, because after the accident I had to see a doctor — and to court (法院).

After the accident, my roommate called a doctor for me.I was very grateful and decided to. repay him one day. But the next day, he asked me to pay him \$ 200 for what he had done.I was very surprised. He had good reason to <u>charge</u> me, he said. And if I wanted to collect money from the person who was responsible (负责) for my injury. I'd have to have a good lawyer (律师). And only a good doctor can help me get a good lawyer. Now that he had helped me find a good doctor, it was only fair that I should pay him.

But every time I went to see the doctor, I had to wait about 50 minutes. He would see two or three patients at the same time, and often stop treating one so as to see another, yet he charged me \$ 115 each time. The final examination report consisted of ten lines, and it cost me \$ 215.

My lawyer knew very well the other party was responsible for the accident, yet he hardly did anything. He simply waited to collect his money. He was so irresponsible that I decided not to ask for him again. And he made me pay him \$ 770.

Now I had to act as my own lawyer. Because of my inexperience, I told the insurance company (保险公司) the date I was leaving America. Knowing that, they played for time, and I left without getting a cent.

My experiences taught me two things about America: firstly, in a country like America money is everything. It is more important than friendship or honor. Secondly, foreigners are still being unfairly treated. So when we talk about America, we should see both its good and bad sides.
