

Naps (小睡) don't just feel amazing -they are amazing. A study published in the magazine Heart found a relationship between healthy napping and a lowered risk of heart disease. The American Peychological Association points out that naps can improve memory, leaning ability, immune system function (免疫功能) and mood. Sara Mednick, the wrier of 7he Power of the Downetate, explains that when

you fall asleep, your body moves through stages that each play a role in health.

Stage 1:the"dozing off"(打瞌唾)period

Stage 2:heart rate (率) and brain activity slow down

Stage 3:deep sleep

Stage 4:REM(rapid eye movement)sleep, when brain activity increases and you're most likely to dream

Ideal napping times are based around this four-stage cycle.

The 20-minute nap

Between 20 and 30 minutes is one napping sweet spot,according to Mednick,who explains that you get enough Stage 2 sleep to turn your body and mind into full relaxation mode,good for memory.

The 60-minute nap

Stage 3 sleep is a time for your body to repair itself,strengthen the immune system and recharge energy stores. But waking up during this stage can make you feel weak or rather ill, Mednick says. Most people start to move out of Stage 3 afer around 60 minutes, which makes it a good time to set your alarm clock.

The 90-minute nap

A complete sleep cycle is about an hour and a half, and napping for a full cycle is of great help. But naps longer than 90 minutes can influence nighttime sleep and might even lead to a bad memory, according to a study in the Journal of the American Geriatrics Society. Not a regular napper? That's OK "Everyone needs to rest, but not everyone necessarily needs to nap, "says Mednick."


Thirty years ago, China started to build its own navigation satellite system(卫星导航系统), Beidou. It took its name from the Bigger Dipper stars, which are the guiding light for people around the world.

In 1994, China began making the Beidou Navigation Satellite System (BDS), so it wouldn't have to use navigation systems from other countries. It's a lot safer this way. In 2020, afer over 20 years of hard work, Beidou completed its global network. The achievement placed China among the group of countries with their own global navigation network. The US, Russia and the European Union are the other three.

Beidou does not just show where you are. It's also the first to let you send texts where there's no phone signal(信号)or intermet.It has now been widely used in international rescue (救援)operations. "It can be of great help in earthquakes, when ground signals are completely cut off," Chen Suzhen, head of the Blue Sky Rescue Team in Xiamen,told CGTN.

On April 25,2015,an earthquake hit Nepal.Lack of proper contact among international rescue teams created main problems in rescue operations."Luckily,our team had BDS.With the short message service,I suggested that we should go to the remote areas where the situation was far worse. The BDS helped us a lot during the rescue. If every country uses the BDS,our future rescue operations will be far more effective" Chen told CGTN.

With 5G technology now in wide use,the "SG+BDS" will be widely applied in conditions that require fast speed,precise (精确的)location and navigation services. For example, the BDS can even help farmers in China by providing precise information for planting and monitoring, making farming smarter.



The GPS and the BDS use the same way to find out position. We can see each satellite as the center of a ball, and its <u>radius</u> is the distance to the position. When there are three satellites, the position can be the two points where three balls meet. Compared with the GPS, the BDS provides navigation signals on multiple frequencies (多频信号) to improve service.

The BDS is more than a system. It shows China's power in science and technology. Now over 120 countries are using it. Wherever you are, Beidou is there to help you find your way.
