

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

76-year-old Mike Adkinson is getting ready to hit the road on Sunday, May 15, because he will be driving his tractor (拖拉机) from Bellingham, Washington State, to Perch Lake, Minnesota.

Mike's brother Dan was diagnosed (诊断) with Parkinson's disease (PD) in 2021 and his family realized they didn't know much about this disease that now has no cure. The Adkinson family started learning about PD and were inspired (受到启发) to make a difference — that's when the idea for a cross-country tractor trip was born.

"I know it may seem like a crazy thing to do, but we need more people to learn about Parkinson's disease and we want to raise money so people like my brother can get the care and support they need," states Mike. "If driving my tractor across country gets people to pay attention or donate, it will all be worth it."

Leaving from Bellingham, Mike will head out on State Route 20 across Washington State which turns into US Highway 2 at the Idaho border. He will stay on US Highway 2 for the rest of his trip through northern Idaho, Montana, North Dakota and Minnesota.

Mike and his tractor will cover more than 1,700 miles. Driving about 12 to 14 miles per hour, he will end his trip by mid-June if all goes as planned! Mike is hoping to meet up with people influenced by Parkinson's disease along the way and has a goal to raise \$50,000. Money raised by Mike's tractor trip will help the American Parkinson Disease Association (APDA) provide important support services, education programs, resources, online wellness and exercise classes, innovative research and more.

"We are so impressed by Mike's strong will and dedication (奉献) to help fight Parkinson's disease. Raising money and awareness is a wonderful way to support his brother and the local PD community " states Jean

Allenbach, Executive Director, APDA Northwest Chapter. "The money he is going to raise will be put to very good use."

Recently Google has announced a series of new artificial intelligence(AI)(人工智能)tools designed to help users in organizing emails and creating business writings and meetings. These tools display important AI development progress in recent years. The tools are built by putting a great deal of data(数据)into machine learning computer systems. The data trains the AI systems to develop skills and produce human-like results.

The technology received wide attention last year after a company called Open AI announced a free writing tool called ChatGPT. That tool can quickly produce human-quality writings. Experts (专家) say such systems may bring great changes to many different industries and jobs. Now some companies are able to test Google's new tools in their development and business activities.

Like ChatGPT, Google's AI tools are designed to create completely written texts for many different purposes. For example, an office worker could enter some keywords of a kind of text they want. The tools could then create a full marketing email, training materials or a business plan in a while. Google sees the system being able to offer an "AI Helper" to help human workers in real time. Google wants to have its AI change the work of lawyers, scientists, teachers and more.

However, Google says it keeps developing AI products of high quality. That is why the company is inviting groups of "trusted testers" to use its AI tools rather than widely selling its new products. Google's new AI tools are the company's latest move to fight for business. Companies like Microsoft and Meta are also working on products about AI.

Technology experts have warned that while the new AI tools can produce human-like writings, the systems can also make mistakes.

Last month, Bard, Google's new AI tool designed to give a better online search, made a mistake and caused a \$100-billion drop. Microsoft users said the company's new AI tools produced unfriendly and rude results.

Hairstyle is thought to be a personal style choice. However, some Chinese students are required by their schools to have unified (统—的) haircuts, with short hair for male students and shoulder-length hair for female students. Some students don't like such hairstyles and have broken the rules in school.

Recently, a complaint letter by a middle school student in Fuzhou, Fujian province as well as the response of the local government to the letter has caught public attention and led to a public discussion.

In the letter, the student wrote, "Our school tells us that it's easy for teenage male students to pay more attention to beautiful female students, so it wants girls to have simple appearances and develop their talents. I highly question whether this kind of requirement really helps students to develop good habits and show good appearances."

"Why can't the school give students a choice to be themselves? Why does the school need to make all the teenage boys pay no attention to girls? Doesn't the school need more sexual (性别的) education?"

The Fuzhou government wrote back to the student and considered him a good student with his own thoughts, courage and truth-seeking spirit. The school asks students to have unified haircuts and wear uniforms simply because it wants teenagers to pay more attention to their studies. Besides, collectivism (集体主义) is very important for the country's development. Although the city has required students to have unified haircuts, schools can set different hairstyle standards that allow students to show their personal styles.


